Charter School Facts & History

Charter schools are publicly funded, privately managed and semiautonomous schools of choice. The first charter school law was passed in 1991 in Minnesota, and the first charter school was established there in 1992. By 1995 an additional 18 states had passed charter school legislation. The charter school movement then experienced tremendous growth.

The Maryland State Legislature approved Maryland's charter school law in 2003.

Just Released: 2020 Voices from the Classroom Survey

Educators for Excellence released the 2020 edition of Voices from the Classroom: A Survey of America's Educators. Charter school teachers are 22 percentage points more likely to say they feel "very valued" and are also more likely to say they've received support and training in key areas. AFC's Annual Education Survey Results Released

The American Federation for Children's annual education survey finds that 58 percent of all voters and 56 percent of Democratic primary voters are less likely to support a candidate who wants to eliminate federal funding for charter schools. Read more in the survey <u>here</u>.

Maryland Ranks 45th in Charter School Law

The National Alliance of Public Charter schools just released their latest state charter law rankings report. For more than a decade, their charter law rankings report has analyzed how well each state aligns its charter school law to their "gold standard" model law. The 2020 charter school law rankings are the first rankings to reflect the impact of the 2018 election cycle. States like California and Illinois, where previous governors supported charter-friendly policies, elected officials who allowed charter opponents to make headway on anti-charter-policies. Those states saw a drop in their rankings. At the same time, advocates made improvements in funding and facilities policies in many states, with Idaho and Tennessee making the biggest jumps. In case you missed it! - Kirwan

The Kirwan Commission, The Commission on the Excellence in Education, wrapped up their work in December 2019. They voted 19 to 3 in favor of their finished recommendations that focused on:

- Investing in High-quality Early Childhood Education and Care
- Elevating Teachers and School Leaders
- Creating a World-class Instructional System
- · Providing More Support to Students Who Need It the Most
- Ensuring Excellence for All with Accountability

On Dec. 3, 2019. the <u>return on investment (ROI) report</u> commissioned by Strong Schools Maryland was released. It noted that Maryland's economy will benefit from the profits and growth that would occur as a result of expanded opportunities mentioned above. It even went as far to say that the recommendations would pay for themselves, over \$4 billion, by 2034.
